PROM

We are pleased to announce that the Junior Class of Urbana High School is hosting its annual prom on Saturday, May 7th at Urbana High School from 8:00 until 11:00 pm. This year's theme is Hollywood.

- You must be at least a third-year student with junior or senior credits to be eligible to attend prom.
- Guest application forms are available in the main office. Any current UHS Junior or Senior may submit one application for a guest to attend the UHS Prom with them. Guests must be either a current high school junior or senior or a high school graduate under the age of 21. The completed guest application form with an attached clear and current photo must be submitted no later than 4:00 pm on April

 18th. There will be no exceptions to this deadline. If you are unable to submit the application and photo to the UHS main office, it can be emailed to Mr. Sever at Nathan. Sever@urbanacityschools.org. UHS students will be notified of the status of their guest application on or before April 22nd.
- In order to be admitted to the prom, students and guests must pre-register at the high school and purchase a prom ticket.
- School fees must be paid **in full before** purchasing tickets.
- Prom tickets will be sold from April 18th-May 5th. Students may purchase tickets from Mrs. Ridge after school only in room 302. Tickets are \$15 per person from April 18th-April 22nd. Tickets are \$20 per person from April 25th-29th. Tickets are \$25 per person from May 2nd-May 5th. Tickets will not be sold the day before the prom (May 6th) or at the door (May 7th).
- Dress Guidelines for the evening will be as follows:
 - Tuxedo, suit, or sports blazer with dress slacks including formal dress shirt and tie (vest and cummerbund are optional)
 - Formal dresses or gowns may be strapless or may feature spaghetti straps. Bare or open backs are acceptable as long as they are no lower than the natural waist. Bare stomachs/midriffs are permitted so long as they do not exceed two inches of exposed skin, sit too high, or sit too low. Holes or openings down the side of the torso are permitted so long as they are not lower than the natural waist or excessively high. Garments that are extremely tight, extremely short, or extremely low-cut are unacceptable. Any adjustments made to a dress or gown to meet these requirements must be a permanent fix, not temporary.

The prom will conclude promptly at 11: 00 pm. The school, class, and faculty cannot sponsor any activities after the official conclusion of the prom. After-Prom is not an official school event but rather an evening of activities planned, sponsored, and chaperoned by a committee of junior class parents.
