COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS

The Virtual College Credit Plus (CCP) Presentation is still available on the Urbana High School website under the Counseling Department link in case you missed it this week. Students who are interested in participating in the CCP program for the 2021-22 school year must complete an Intent to Participate form on or before **April 1, 2021**. The form is available with this newsletter and on our website and social media sites. The form was also sent out through Remind. There will be a section on the intent form for the student and parent to initial that you have watched the presentation.

ACT and ASVAB TESTING

On Tuesday, February 23rd, Sophomores and Juniors will participate in group testing. It is a required testing day. The **Sophomore** class will be taking the ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery). This is a FREE, NO STAKES test that will allow your student to identify their interests through a comprehensive Interest Inventory and then participate in a skills test that will cross-reference with their interests to indicate careers in which they would be successful (skills) and enjoy (interests). NO MILITARY RECRUITMENT WILL OCCUR!

All **Juniors** will participate in the state offered FREE administration of the ACT (American College Test). ACT is a standardized test used for college admissions in the United States. The ACT test covers four academic skill areas: English, mathematics, reading and scientific reasoning. Scores are reported to colleges and universities when applying for admission. High scores can also influence/contribute to scholarship monies and or reduced tuition at many state and private colleges. In the next few weeks, Counselors will be disseminating information to students through classroom presentations and communication with UVA students and Ohio Hi-Point students. Please do not hesitate to contact your student's counselor if you have any questions or concerns. With a signed parent permission form on file, **Sophomore** and **Junior** students will be permitted to be excused when all testing is completed around midday.

Freshman and **Seniors** will NOT report to school on this date.
