
CCP

If your student is interested in taking College Credit Plus courses next year, a parent/guardian and the student need to attend a CCP Presentation and submit an intent form by **April 1, 2022**. If you were unable to attend the presentation in January, it is available on your student's Google Classroom grade level page. CCP is open to students who will be in 7th-12th grades for the 2022/2023 school year. Completing this information does not commit your student to anything, but per ODE rules, they cannot participate in College Credit Plus if these steps are not completed. Please be aware that this is required each year to be able to participate, including taking CCP courses at Urbana High School. PROM

We are pleased to announce that the Junior Class of Urbana High School is hosting its annual prom on Saturday, May 7th at Urbana High School from 8:00 until 11:00 pm. This year's theme is Hollywood.

- You must be at least a third-year student with junior or senior credits to be eligible to attend prom.
- A guest application form is available in the main office. These forms are due to the main office by April
 18th. Guest application forms will <u>not</u> be accepted after April 18th! UHS students will be
 notified of the status of their guest application on or before April 22nd. (See the student handbook for
 further guidelines.)
- In order to be admitted to the prom, students and guests must pre-register at the high school and purchase a prom ticket.
- School fees must be paid in full BEFORE purchasing tickets.
- Prom tickets will be sold from April 18th May 5th. Students may purchase tickets from Mrs. Ridge after school only. Tickets are \$15 per person from April 18th April 22nd. Tickets are \$20 per person from April 25th April 29th. Tickets are \$25 per person from May 2nd May 5th. Tickets will not be sold the day before the prom (May 6th) or at the door (May 7th).



File a 2021 Tax Return to Get the Remainder of Your 2021 Child Tax Credit

Many families got up to half of their estimated 2021 Child Tax Credit as advance payments last year. Here are three steps to getting the rest of your credit:

Step 1: Review Letter 6419

- You should have received this letter in January 2022 if you received advance Child Tax Credit payments in 2021.
- It shows the amount of advance payments you received and the number of qualifying children the payments were based on.
- You or your tax preparer will use this information to figure your remaining credit accurately.
- If you misplaced your letter, you can look up your information using the IRS's CTC Update Portal or Online Account.

Step 2: Claim the Rest of Your 2021 Child Tax Credit

- File your 2021 federal tax return and claim the Child Tax Credit, if you're eligible.
- Choose direct deposit if you're getting a refund. Make sure your bank account information is correct.

Step 3: Get Paid!

- After you file your return, you can check on the status of your refund using the Where's My Refund? tool on IRS.gov or the mobile app IRS2Go.
- You can check within 24 hours of e-filing or within four weeks of mailing a return. Updates to the online tool are made daily, usually overnight.
- To use this tool, you need your Social Security number, filing status and the exact whole dollar amount of your refund.

Important Information

- » Filing a tax return is the only way to get the remainder of your 2021 Child Tax Credit.
- » Electronic filing with direct deposit is the safest and fastest way to get a tax refund.
- » Many people qualify for free e-filing through IRS Free File or at a volunteer tax preparation site.
