UHS FFA

The Urbana FFA attended the 95th National FFA Convention on October 27th – 29th. The National FFA Organization is a national youth organization of over 850,823 student members as part of over 8,995 local FFA chapters in all 50 states, Puerto Rico, Guam and the Virgin Islands. While attending the convention, The Urbana FFA chapter made stops at the Holdfast Hilty Alpaca farm in Medway, Ohio and the Indianapolis Motor Speedway. There were several colleges that presented different educational pathways and opportunities offered at their school. Students also attended a rodeo at the Indianapolis State Fair! On Saturday, Janie Wallace received her American Degree. The American Degree is the highest degree achievable in the National FFA Organization. To earn the American Degree, Janie had to receive the state degree, earn at least \$10,000, productively invest \$7,500, and participate in at least 50 hours of community service.



UHS DECA

Thirty-nine UHS DECA members traveled to Dayton for our Ohio DECA District 4 Fall competition. Students competed against district schools of Beavercreek, Centerville, Edgewood, Fairborn, Kettering Fairmont, Northmont and Xenia. Twenty-one of the thirty-nine chapter members returned home with a medal, placing in the top 3 of their event. UHS DECA will be back at the district competition in late January to have students compete for spots at the Ohio DECA State Career Development Conference. That competition will take place March 10-11 in Columbus, Ohio, and will be against all DECA chapters in the state of Ohio where we will look to qualify many more students for the International Career Development Conference in Orlando, Florida in late April.
